Following is a summary of the programs available from UWCA's Financial Stability Partnership to help you save money and take control of your finances.

- Free Tax Preparation UWCA recruits IRS-Certified volunteers who prepare income tax returns for qualified individuals on-site every year. www.uwca.org/taxes
- Family Stability Services We help low-to-moderate-income families with schoolaged children get back on track when in danger of losing their homes. www.uwca.org/fss
- Housing Counseling UWCA is approved by HUD to provide prospective homeowners and renters the information and support they need to achieve their housing goals.
- Individual Development Account We offer a matched-savings program that helps qualified participants save for major goals, such as purchasing a home for the first time, paying for college or job training or starting or expanding a small business. www.uwca.org/ida
