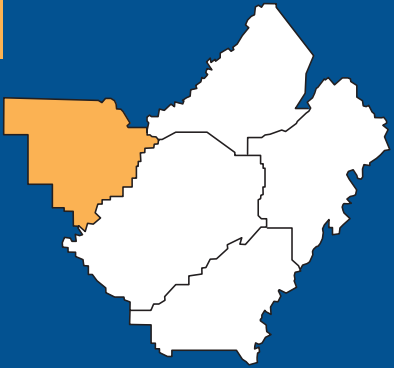

563 county residents contacted United Way's **2-1-1 Call Center** to be connected with resources they needed.



188 children received glasses, school uniforms and supplies and help with dental and medical services through the **Central Alabama Children's Fund**.



39 residents received **free tax preparation assistance**.



United Way supports the **Walker County Health Action Partnership** that has leveraged over **\$977,000** in grant funding to implement a healthy after-school program, expand local waterway access for kayaking and canoeing on the Alabama Scenic River Trail, and begun implementation of the Walker County Lake Master Plan.
