A LITTLE HELP CAN MAKE A BIG DIFFERENCE

Individuals who qualify for United Way Area Agency on Aging's Homemaker and Personal Care program:

- Are age 60 or older.
- Are residents of Jefferson County.
- Live alone and need help for a minimum of two hours per week with two or more activities of daily living.

Homemaker Services may include:

- Light Housekeeping, such as dusting, vacuuming, etc.
- Changing bed linens.
- Laundry.
- Light meal preparation.

Personal Care Services may include:

- Bathing assistance.
- Dressing and/or grooming assistance.
- Toileting.
- Feeding.
- Ambulation.
- Medication reminders.
