The Blount County Children's Center is focused on preventing child abuse, helping victims and strengthening families. The highly trained professional staff utilizes a low-stress team approach to investigation, lessening the risk of re-traumatizing the child. Children and non-offending family members receive free therapy. The organization also conducts school-based prevention programs and works to spread awareness about preventing, recognizing and reporting child abuse throughout the community.
