



A PRESCRIPTION DRUG ASSISTANCE PROGRAM THAT COULD BE YOUR CURE FOR HIGH PRICES

SenioRx is a program for qualified residents of Jefferson County, who require prescription drugs for a diagnosed chronic health condition. Qualified seniors and individuals with disabilities may be eligible for free or low-cost prescription medications from pharmaceutical companies.

SenioRx was established by the Governor's Office and the Alabama State Legislature, and is locally administered by United Way's Area Agency on Aging.

YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR FREE OR LOW-COST PRESCRIPTIONS WITH SENIORx

To be eligible for prescription medication assistance through the SenioRx program, your annual income must not exceed certain limits. Call 1-800-AGE-LINE to see if your income falls within the qualified range.

IN ADDITION TO the income limitation, one or more of the following conditions must be met to qualify:

- You are age 55 or older with a diagnosed chronic health condition that requires prescription medication.
- OR you are currently in the Medicare Part D Coverage Gap (formerly known as the Donut Hole).
- OR, regardless of age, you have been deemed by Social Security to have a disability.
- OR you have applied for disability and are waiting on a decision.
- OR you have a doctor's declaration of disability and are in the 24-month Medicare waiting period.
