

SHELBY COUNTY



Owens House was founded in 1993 to conduct forensic interviews concerning child abuse. By 2003, the agency's partner base expanded to offer more comprehensive care to the children of Shelby County. Today, Owens House has a staff of five full-time professionals in mental health, social work, criminal justice and community education. The organization supports children and their families in matters involving sexual abuse, child sex trafficking, sexual exploitation, physical abuse, severe neglect, drug endangerment and witnessing violent crimes.

137,182 Shelby County residents were served by United Way of Central Alabama funding.*

450 children served by The Arc of Shelby County through early intervention and care programs.

530 clients served by SafeHouse of Shelby County's crisis services to help them recover from physical or emotional abuse.

25,116 pounds of food distributed by Shelby Emergency Assistance to residents experiencing food insecurity.
