

# ST. CLAIR COUNTY



Since 1999, St. Clair County Day Program has been dedicated to reducing juvenile crime in the area by providing a positive, cost-effective alternative to incarceration, residential treatment or hospitalization of high-risk youth. The organization serves boys and girls ages 13 to 18 through academic remediation and GED preparation, as well as individual, group and family counseling to address issues such as mental health, alcohol/substance abuse and prevention.

**78,890** St. Clair County residents were served by United Way of Central Alabama funding.\*

**8,028** youth served by St. Clair Children's Advocacy Center (The Children's Place) in local schools through programs that help to identify and prevent child abuse.

**173** clients who do not have the ability to pay for hospice care served by Lakeside Hospice.

**1,410** clients served by Christian Love Pantry through distribution of 100,500 pounds of food to St. Clair County residents.
